All these issues are currently under investigation.

Some people have expressed concerns over the Governments White Paper on Local Government reorganisation. At the present time there are no concrete proposals how this may work in Derbyshire, with no agreement either politically or between organisations. It is therefore likely that Derbyshire will be at the back end of any enforced mergers involving the County and/or City Councils. The Government have stated the process will take between 2 and 5 years. My personal prediction is that the District elections scheduled for May 2027 will be for a shadow authority to come into effect in April 2028, but that is just a personal guess, it could be later than that.

#### District Councillor: Sundip Meghani

South Derbyshire District Council (SDDC) are no longer providing a pest control service following the resignation of the pest control officer. The service was not viable, SDDC are hoping to be able to recommend trusted traders in the near future from the private market.

### **County Councillor Julie Patten**

Derbyshire County Council have moved forward with devolution and unitary authority status. A letter has been sent by our leader to government asking to be considered in the first wave. Just to be clear this is being imposed on us by the labour government and we must be ahead of the game to keep Derbyshire together. We have no idea what Derby City are intending, however we should know our position by the end of January. The result from government will also determine whether county elections will be held or not. I will have more to update you at the next meeting.

I have been asked to put forward areas of roads, pavements for capital projects. There are no guarantees of inclusion but if we don't ask.....please let me know of any areas to be considered.

I have also reported Leathersley Lane in for inspection.
