We have received your report re fly tipping in Scropton area. We do enforce in these areas but if there is no evidence we can't prosecute. In your email you mentioned cameras. We use cameras and in prolific areas such as Arleston Lane near Stenson fields the Parish council helped purchase some cameras. It maybe worth speaking to me before you do anything like this as we use cameras that stop glare so that number plates can be read at night. Attached is a link and we have purchased some of these but are now looking at others using sim cards so we can view on our devices at the office.

If you or any councillors want to discuss I am happy to show you soe of what we have and could put some in regular fly tip hot spots. The problem is we aren't always told about every fly tip.
